The writ petition is filed to direct the respondents 2 and 3 to afford adequate police protection to the life of the petitioner and her family members from any threat of the 4^{th} respondent and his men.

- 2. When the writ petition came up for consideration on 25.08.2023, this Court directed the $3^{\rm rd}$ respondent to afford adequate police protection to the life of the petitioner from the threat of the $4^{\rm th}$ respondent without interfering in any civil dispute between the parties.
- 3. Heard; the learned counsel for the petitioner, the learned Government Pleader and the learned counsel for the $4^{\rm th}$ respondent.
- 4. The learned counsel for the 4^{th} respondent submitted that, Ext.P1 title deed has already been set

aside by the Court of Subordinate Judge, Thodupuzha in O.S.No.80/2023. Therefore, the petitioner has no legal right to reside in the property covered by Ext.P1.

5. On a consideration of the facts and materials on record, I am of the view that a quietus can be given to the writ petition, by permitting the petitioner to approach the 3rd respondent, in case there is any threat to her life. If such complaint is filed, the 3rd respondent shall act upon the complaint, without interfering in any civil dispute between the petitioner and the 4th respondent.

The writ petition is ordered accordingly.
