The marital relationship is strained. The petitioner and the child are residing in the petitioner's parental home in Thiruvananthapuram. There is no the chaperone petitioner from person to Thiruvananthapuram to Wayanad to contest Annexure-1. On a comparison of relative hardship, due preference and weightage has to be given to the petitioner and the child. Hence, the transfer petition.

3. Heard; Sri.Sreejith S.Nair, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner. Even though notice has been served on the respondent, there is no appearance for him.

The with respect to transfer of proceedings, particularly matrimonial disputes, is no longer res-integra, in view of the categoric declaration of law by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Sumitha Sing V. Kumar Sanjay and another [2002 KHC 1889], Mona Aresh Goel V. Aresh Satya Goel [2000 KHC 1835], Vaishali Shridhar Jagtap V. Shridhar Vishwanath Jagtap [2016] KHC 64891, Santhini V. Vijaya Venkatesh [2017 (5) KHC 48] and N.C.V Aishwarya vs. **A.S Saravana Karthik Sha** [2022 (5) KHC 182]. Supreme Court has held that Hon'ble it convenience of the woman and children that has to be looked into, while ordering the transfer of a case from one Court to another.

5. In the light of the law laid down in the aforecited decisions, the pleadings and materials on record, the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case, particularly the fact that the petitioner is a 24 year old lady and has a one year old child, I am inclined to exercise the discretionary powers of this Court under Sec.24 of the Code of Civil Procedure and order the transfer of Annexure 1 from the Family Court Kalpetta.

In the result, I allow the transfer petition as follows:

- (i) OP (D)No.507/2022 is transferred from the Family Court, Kalpetta to the Family Court, Thiruvananthapuram.
- (ii) The Registry shall forward a copy of this order to the Family Court, Kalpetta, with instructions to forthwith transmit the records in Annexure-1 to the Family Court, Thiruvananthpuram.

(iii) The Family Court, Thiruvananthpuram, shall,immediately on receipt of the records in Annexure-1, issue notice to the parties for their appearance.
