THIS WRIT PETITION (CIVIL) HAVING COME UP FOR ADMISSION ON 09.04.2024, THE COURT ON THE SAME DAY DELIVERED THE FOLLOWING:

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Amidst the various allegations, averments and assertions, when I considered this matter today, the learned counsel for the petitioner - Sri.Ramees P.K., confined his plea that respondent be directed to consider Ext.P7 Nos.7 and 8 P8 representations, so as to lead to a thorough, impartial and expeditious investigation into the alleged financial mismanagement of the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent - Thennala Service Cooperative Bank, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.

2. Sri.P.P.Thajudeen - learned Special Government Pleader, however, in response submitted that Ext.P8 has not been received by respondent No.8; but that, since it contains very grievous allegations, the Authorities concerned are willing to take it up from the files of this case and hear the parties, to arrive at a final decision. He, however, prayed that this court may not make any affirmative declarations in favour of the petitioner and leave it to the competent Authority to take an appropriate decision thereon, as per law.

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3. Taking note of the afore submissions and the limited plea of the petitioner, I allow this writ petition and direct the 8<sup>th</sup> respondent to take up Ext.P8 representation and dispose of the same, after affording an opportunity of being heard to the petitioner and to any other person who may be interested; thus culminating in an appropriate order and necessary action thereon, within a period of three months.

In order to obtain an expeditious compliance of the afore directions, I direct the petitioner to produce a certified copy of this judgment, along with a full set of this writ petition, before the 8<sup>th</sup> respondent; and the afore time frame will begin from the day on which this is done.
