**JUDGMENT**

The petitioner, who is a UPST in the school managed by the 7<sup>th</sup> respondent, has approached this Court being aggrieved by Ext.P1 staff fixation order as reviewed as per Ext.P2. The petitioner moved the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent, with Ext.P3 revision petition, which was dismissed as per Ext.P5. Aggrieved by the same, Ext.P6 revision petition has been submitted by the petitioner which is pending before the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent.

2. Limited prayer sought for by the petitioner is for a direction to the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent to pass appropriate orders thereon within a time frame.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Pleader, this writ petition is disposed of directing the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent to take up Ext.P6 and pass appropriate orders thereon in accordance with law after hearing the petitioner, 7<sup>th</sup> respondent and any other affected parties. Orders in this regard shall be passed within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment.
