## **JUDGMENT**

The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs:

- "i. To issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order, or direction this Hon'ble Court may deem fit, commanding the 1st respondent to issue Police Clearance Certificate to the petitioner, stating that there is a criminal case pending against the petitioner and that the criminal court has permitted the petitioner to go abroad to pursue his employment in the interest of justice;
- ii. To issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper, commanding the 1st respondent to consider the application submitted by the petitioner within a stipulated time period and to pass appropriate orders in the same after affording the petitioner an opportunity to be heard."
- 2. Learned Counsel for the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent submits that the petitioner cannot be issued a Police Clearance Certificate when a criminal case is pending against him. However, the Regional Passport Authority can issue a customized Police

Clearance Certificate in view of this Court's judgment in Siju v.

3. Considering the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent's stand, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to expeditiously consider the petitioner's application for issuing a customized Police Clearance Certificate, as directed by this Court in the case of **Siju** (supra).
