JUDGMENT

The petitioner and her team members participated in 'Oppana' (H.S.S. catergory) in the Kasargod Revenue District School Kalolsavam 2024-2025 held at G.H.S.S., Udinoor. They were awarded third 'A' grade in the competition.

- 2. The grievance of the petitioner is that her team was unjustly awarded third place in the competition. Further, the teams that secured first and second places deviated from the fundamental components. The video evidence confirms that the winning teams not only omitted crucial segments but also sang the songs incorrectly. It is alleged that there were technical defects also on part of the respondents. Even though the allegation was raised in the appeal, that was not adverted to.
- 3. I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Pleader for the respondents.
- 4. A perusal of Ext.P2 shows that the appeal committee had verified the appeal in detail with the video and

score sheet and found against the petitioner. This Court relies on the judgment of a reported decision in **Devna Sumesh v. State of Kerala [2022 KHC 8081]**, wherein it is held that this Court cannot sit in appeal over award of marks by panel of judges in a proceedings under Article 226 and the decision of appeal committees shall be accepted as conclusive and final.

If appeals are allowed indiscriminately, schedule and conduct of the State Level competitions will be completely disrupted. Therefore, no interference is warranted under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed.
