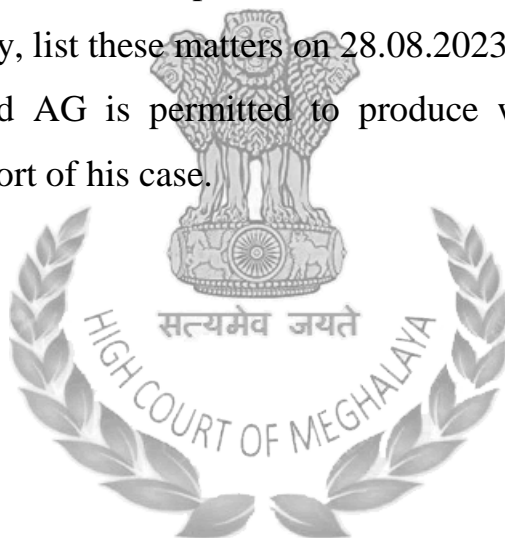
affidavit filed by the petitioners has not yet been filed, he prays for 3(three) days' time, and that the matter can be taken up next week, to enable him to file the said affidavit.
