The petitioner is aggrieved with the auction notice, which has been issued in pursuance to the proceedings taken up against the petitioner under the Securitization Act.

The record reflects that the petitioner has already approached the DRT, Jabalpur by filing an S.A. along with the application for stay.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that the DRT, Jabalpur is not functioning and the Presiding Officer, DRT, Lucknow, who is hearing the matters of DRT, Jabalpur is on leave, therefore, the petitioner was compelled to approach this Court.

Learned counsel for the respondent has informed that the Presiding Officer of the DRT, Lucknow was on leave only upto 6th of March, 2021 and he has resumed thereafter and is hearing the matters of DRT, Jabalpur.

In the aforesaid circumstances, we dispose of the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to prosecute his second appeal before the DRT.

Having regard to the nature of urgency, which has been pointed out before this Court, the authorised officer, DRT, Jabalpur/Lucknow is directed to consider the petitioner's prayer for urgent hearing without any delay and take appropriate steps in this regard.

Writ Petition is accordingly disposed of.
