This is first application for grant of bail in connection with Crime No. 9/2017 registered at Police Station Gunnor, District Panna for the offence punishable under Section 136 of the M.P. Electricity Act read with Sections 379, 411 of the I.P.C & Section 3(2) (Ka) Lok Sampatti Ka Nuksani Niwaran Adhiniyam.

The applicant has been arrested on the charges of having been in possession of electricity wire which, according to the prosecution, has been stolen by the applicant herein. Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the applicant is history sheeter and has 7 cases each registered against him.

From perusal of the record, it reveals that all the 7 cases were registered against the applicant herein on the same day in similar cases pending before different police stations. The applicant has been in judicial custody since 01.02.2017 and the charge-sheet has been filed.

Under the circumstances, I am inclined to allow the application and direct that the applicant be enlarged on bail upon his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only) with one solvent surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of

the Trial Court. Cc as per rules.
