## W.P. No. 17975 of 2012

Heard on the question of admission.

The petitioner has filed writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for quashment of the order dated 29.9.2012, (Ann. P-9) passed by the respondent no. 2, the Secretary of the Regional Transport Authority, Rewa granting impugned permit to the respondent no. 3 for the route from Saleha to Satna contrary to the interest of the petitioner only one minute ahead from the bus of the petitioner which is plied at regular permit.

In the course of arguments, I am apprised by the petitioner's counsel that his objection/ representation dated 8.10.2012, (Ann. P-11) is pending before the authority of the respondent no. 2 for adjudication but for one reason or another best known to the authorities, the same has not been decided till today and prayed to dispose of this petition with appropriate direction to the authorities of the respondents to decide such representation on some early date with some time bound schedule. He also prayed that subject to order of such authority on such representation on arising the occasion he should be extended the liberty to file appropriate appeal/revision before the Transport Appellate Tribunal, Gwalior.

The State's counsel did not have any objection on the aforesaid limited prayer of the petitioner's counsel.

In view of aforesaid, instead to admit this petition or issue any notice to the other side, the petition is disposed of with a

direction to the authorities of the respondent no. 2 to consider and decide the aforesaid representation/objection of the petitioner Annexure P-11 within 30 days from the date of filing the certified copy of this order alongwith copy of the petition and Annexures by the petitioner and the petitioner's counsel is directed to submit such documents in the office of such authorities within ten days from today.
