Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

This Contempt Petition is filed alleging violation of this Court's order dated 13.1.2020, passed in W.P.(C) No.504 of 2020.

Considering the submission made and as this Court finds, no purpose will be served in issuing notice in such matter, the Contempt Petition stands disposed of with direction to the Opposite Party-contemnor to work out the direction of this Court dated 13.1.2020, passed in W.P.(C) No.504 of 2020, if not worked out in the meantime, within a period of one month from the date of service of a copy of this order by the petitioner, provided there is no legal impediment otherwise. It is made clear that in the event the order of this Court is not worked out within the time stipulated hereinabove, it will be construed to be deliberate violation of this Court's order.

As restriction is continuing for COVID-19, petitioner may utilize the soft copy of this order available in the High Court's website or print out thereof at par with certified copies in the manner prescribed, vide Court's Notice No.4587, dated 25.03.2020.
