1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that no offence is made out against the petitioners considering the nature of complaint. It is submitted that such a complaint is filed by sole

opposite party with the allegation that without any prior permission, the petitioners dug a safety tank over the land which is being used by the public as a pathway which runs between the CSI office and civil court building. It is also claimed that the petitioner is the contractor whereas petitioner No.2 is a JE of PHD and therefore, the complaint with such allegation cannot be sustained in law and hence, the proceeding arising therefrom should be stayed as an interim measure.

- 2. Considering the nature of allegations in the complaint and submission of learned counsel for the petitioners, this Court as an interim measure directs that the proceeding in 1CC Case No.15 of 2022 pending in the file of learned S.D.J.M., Padampur shall remain stayed till the next date.
