Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Addl. Government Advocate for the State.

In this writ petition, the petitioner, being the petitioner in Settlement Revision Petition No.1759/2015 has filed an application under Section 15(b) and 15(D) of the Odisha Survey and Settlement Act, 1958 before the Commissioner, Consolidation and Settlement, Odisha, Bhubaneswar (opposite party no.2). The limited prayer of the petitioner is that her case is not being taken up for final disposal by the opposite party no.2.

Since many cases are pending before the Commissioner and the concerned settlement revision petition is of the year, 2015, it will be appropriate for the petitioner to file an application before the opposite party no.2 for early disposal of the case.

In that view of the matter, this Court disposes of the writ petition giving liberty to the petitioner to file an application before the opposite party no.2 for early disposal of the aforesaid revision case within a period of ten working days. On such event, the opposite party no.2 shall consider whether there is any good reason for expeditious disposal of the revision case filed by her and if there are some good grounds, opposite party no.2 shall take a decision thereon subject to pendency of the cases before him and other legal priorities, if any.

Urgent certified copy of this order be granted as per rules.
