1. Heard learned counsel for the Parties.
2. This is in second round of litigation by the Petitioner. In the first round of litigation Petitioner became unsuccessful but in disposal of the Writ Petition there was permission to the Petitioner to withdraw the Writ Petition to approach the Land Reforms Commissioner, Board of Revenue, Cuttack for redressal of his grievance.
3. It is alleged that pursuant to the direction in disposed of the Writ Petition vide W.P.(C) No.11797 of 2022, there has been some development as appearing at page-34 of the brief was the Establishment Officer communicate the Tahasildar, Hatadihi, Keonjhar for working out in the manner described therein and submitting the information to his end at an early date. This letter appears to have been issued by the Tahasildar on 21.10.2022.
4. Considering there is unnecessary delay, Petitioner in the meantime has also approached the Land Reforms Commissioner, Board of Revenue, Cuttack once again vide Annexure-10 claiming to

be eliding no result. Considering the exercise is required at the end of the Tahasildar, Hatadihi, Keonjhar pursuant to the request of the Petitioner dated 02.06.2022 and direction of the Establishment Officer, Office of the Land Reforms Commissioner, Board of Revenue, Cuttack dated 21.10.2022, this Court in disposal of the Writ Petition directs the Tahasildar, Hatadihi, Keonjhar-Opposite Party No.4 to complete the required exercise at least within a period of two months from the date of communication of this order by the Petitioner.

5. With this observation, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.
