- 2. Heard Mr. A.K.Biswal, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. A. Mishra, learned counsel for opposite parties no.3 and 4.
- 3. Mr. A.K.Biswal, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has received counter affidavit filed by opposite parties no.3 and 4 and wants to file rejoinder affidavit. He, however, contended that the bank has floated a scheme on 28.11.2022 wherein it has been stated that the bank wants to resolve the disputes which are pending with the parties. Therefore, the petitioner may be permitted to move the bank in terms of the scheme floated on 28.11.2022 so that the dispute can be resolved at the level of the bank, to which learned counsel appearing for the opposite party-bank has raised no objection.
- 4. In view of the above submission, this writ petition stands disposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to pursue his remedy
