02. 22.04.2021 The matter is taken up by video conferencing mode.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to appoint the son of the petitioner in the vacant post of peon in place of her late husband in Dr. Sadananda Tripathy Bidyapitha, G. Nuagam in the district of Ganjam or in any other place vacancy is available on the basis of the application under Orissa Civil Service (Rehabilitation Assistance) Rules, 1990.

In course of hearing, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievance, the petitioner has made representation to opposite party no.3 vide Annexure-6, and direction may be given to consider and dispose of the same taking into consideration the judgment passed by this Court in Ritanjali Giri v. State of Orissa, 2016 (I) ILR CUT 1162, within a stipulated time.

In view of the aforesaid limited grievance of the petitioner, this Court disposes of the writ petition directing opposite party no.3 to take a decision on the representation filed by the petitioner under Annexure-6 taking into consideration the judgment passed by this Court in *Ritanjali* Giri v. State of Orissa, 2016 (I) ILR CUT 1162 and pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production of authenticated/certified copy of this order.

As the restrictions due to resurgence of COVID-19 situation are continuing, learned counsel for the parties may utilize a print out of the order available in the High Court's website, at par with certified copy, subject to attestation by the concerned advocate, in the manner prescribed, vide Court's Notice No.4587 dated 25th March, 2020, as modified by Court's notice no. 4798 dated 15th April, 2021.
