- 02.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. The Petitioner has filed the present Writ Petition with the following prayer: -

“Under the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is therefore, prayed that this Hon’ble Court may graciously be pleased to issue notice to the Opp. Parties as to why the constitution of School Managing Committee of Kalan Madhupur Govt. High School shall not be declared illegal and the said School Managing Committee shall not be reconstituted strictly in accordance with School Managing Committee guideline and appropriated action shall not be initiated against the Headmaster, Asst. Block Education Officer etc. for their achieve involvement with outsiders (not members of PTA) in formation of such blatantly illegal School Managing Committee.

If the Opp. Parties fail to show cause this Hon'ble Court may pass such order/direction as the Hon'ble Court considers appropriate."

4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that through highlighting his grievances, the petitioner has filed a representation vide Annexure-6 to the Writ Petition, but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, he prays that a direction be issued to opposite party No.3 to take a decision on the above noted petition within a specific time period.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs opposite party No.3 to take a decision on the above noted petition in accordance with law, within a period of two months from the date of production of certified copy of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

6. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
