# ORDER 26.04.2024

- 01. 1. Heard the learned counsel for the Petitioners and the State.
  - 2. By means of this application, the Petitioners seek grant of bail U/s.438 Cr.P.C. in apprehension of arrest for their alleged involvement in the offences U/s.341/294/323/307/354/379/34 of IPC in connection with Keonjhar Town P.S. Case No.208 of 2024 corresponding to G.R. Case No.735 of 2024 pending in the court of the learned S.D.J.M., Keonjhar.
  - 3. It is alleged in the F.I.R. that the present Petitioners abused her in obscene languages when the Informant opposed to burnt the garbage on her ways and taking the video, the Petitioners snatched the mobile and outraged her modesty and assaulted her husband by means of brick resulting her husband sustained head injury.
  - 4. Keeping in view the nature of allegations, the circumstances appearing, the seriousness and gravity of the offences, while this

Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail, it is directed that in the event the Petitioners surrender and move for bail in connection to Keonjhar Town P.S Case No.208 of 2024 within a period of three weeks hence, they shall be admitted to bail on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the said court subject to deposit a sum of Rs.4,000/- (Rupees four thousand) each in the manner to be directed by the court.

- 5. It is made clear that the court shall verify the criminal antecedent in respect to the Petitioners and ensure the injuries are not grievous to the vital part of the body. In case antecedent is noticed and/or the injuries are found grievous to the vital part of the body, the order of this Court shall not be given effect to and the court shall be free to deal with matter of bail according to its merit without further reference to the present.
- 6. The ABLAPL is disposed of accordingly.
