1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. The Petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to Opposite Party Nos.1 to 4 to allow him to continue in his present place of working as In-charge Headmaster in Barashi U.G. High School in the district of Nayagarh till the post of headmaster is filled up by Level-II Headmaster of Elementary Cadre Rules.
3. In course of hearing, Mr. Pattnaik, learned counsel for the Petitioner states that highlighting the grievance, the Petitioner has made representation to the Opposite Party No.4 vide Annexure-8 and direction be given to consider and dispose of the same within a stipulated time.
4. Taking into consideration the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, this Court without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the writ petition with a direction that in the event the Petitioner files a fresh representation before the District Education Officer, Nayagarh-Opposite Party No.4 redressing his grievances for continuance in the present place as well as for release of salary,

within a period of two weeks hence along with certified copy of this order, he shall do well to consider and dispose of the same within a period of one month from the date of production of certified copy of this order.
