1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
 2. The petitioner is an accused in connection with G.R Case No. 277 of 2023, pending before the Court of the learned S.D.J.M., Keonjhar, arising out of Keonjhar P.S. Case No.103 of 2023 for alleged commission of offences under Sections 379 of IPC.
 3. Being aggrieved by the rejection of his application for bail U/s.439 Cr.P.C. by the learned Sessions Judge, Keonjhar by order dated 07.06.2023 in the aforementioned case, the present BLAPL has been filed.
 4. It is submitted by the Learned counsel that the Petitioner has been remanded in the case at hand on 11.03.2023, on the accusation of committing theft of Rs. 30,000/- from the scooty of the informant.

5. Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for bail since investigation is continuing and the Petitioner has antecedent of similar nature relating to which affidavit has been placed on record.

6. Considering the nature of accusation, this Court directs the Petitioner to be released on bail on such terms to be fixed by the learned Court in seisin.

7. Additionally, it is directed the Petitioner shall deposit cash security of Rs. 30,000/- without prejudice to his rights and claims before the learned Court in seisin, which shall abide by the final outcome of this Case.

8. It shall be open to the informant to seek release of the informant in accordance with law.

9. Accordingly, the BLAPL stands disposed of.

10. Urgent certified copy of this order be granted as per rule.
