Heard Mr.Mohapatra, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.Y.S.Babu, learned Addl. Government Advocate.

According to learned counsel for the petitioner, the grievance of the petitioner in this petition relates to non-registration of his complaint dated 27.08.2019 under Annexure-1 as F.I.R. by the Inspector-in-Charge, Baidyanathpur P.S. (opp. party No.4) though the same reveals commission of cognizable offences. He further submits that though against such inaction, the petitioner has submitted a copy of the complaint under Annexure-1 to the Superintendent of Police, Ganjam (opp. party No.3) through registered post on 16.9.2019, however, till date, nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, he prays that necessary direction be issued to opp. party No.3 to take a decision on the above noted complaint of the petitioner within a specific time period.

Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs the opposite party No.3 to take a decision on the complaint of the under Annexure-1, which was sent through registered post on 16.09.2019, in accordance with law, keeping in mind the decision rendered by the Supreme Court in **Lalita Kumari -vrs- State of U.P. and others** reported in **A.I.R. 2014 S.C. 187** within a period of four weeks from the date of production of certified copy of this order, if in the meantime, the same has not been disposed of. The petitioner be communicated with the result of such exercise.
