- 01. 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
 - 2. Being aggrieved by the alleged inaction of the Police Authorities in registering the complaint at Annexure-1 as FIR, the present CRLMP has been filed.
 - 3. Considering the submissions of the counsel for the Parties, this Court directs the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Bhubaneswar, Opposite Party No.2, to take a decision on the complaint of the Petitioner at Annexure-2 in accordance with the provisions of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1978 and the law laid down by the Apex Court in the case of Lalita Kumari vs. Government of U.P. & others, **AIR 2014 SC 187**, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order along with copy of the CRLMP.

- 4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner undertakes to submit the certified copy of the order passed by this Court and the copy of the CRLMP by registered post/speed post within a period of one week from the date of receipt of the certified copy.
- 5. If in the meantime the grievance of the Petitioner has been redressed, the Petitioner shall be intimated the result thereof.
- 6. Liberty is also granted to the Petitioner to renew her prayer if her grievance still subsists.
- 7. Accordingly, the CRLMP stands disposed of.
- 8. Urgent certified copy of this order be granted as per the rules.
