1. The petitioner is aggrieved by the order dated 22.06.2024 passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Berhampur in Criminal Appeal No.40 of 2024, whereby admitting the appeal of the appellant against the conviction and sentence order passed by the learned J.M.F.C. (LR & LTV), Berhampur on 17.05.2024, directed the petitioner to deposit 20% of the compensation amount as per Section 148(A) of the N.I. Act.



- **2.** Mr. Sidharth Sankar Ray (2), Advocate has entered appearance for the opposite party on advance notice.
- 3. This matter was heard at length and the parties have ultimately agreed to the term that the petitioner, to begin with, shall pay 10% of the compensation amount within four weeks and the matter shall be relegated to the mediation center for exploring the possibility of full and final settlement between the parties.
- **4.** Accordingly, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to pay 10% of the compensation amount to begin with.
- **5.** The learned Sessions Judge, Berhampur is directed to relegate the matter to the District Meditation Center to explore the possibility of out of the Court settlement between the parties. If the settlement in any case fails, then the Appellate Court may proceed to hear the appeal as expeditiously as possible.
- **6.** With the aforementioned observation, the CRLMC is disposed of.
