01. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

Mr. P.K. Parhi, learned DSGI along with Mr. Millan Kumar, learned Central Govt. Counsel has filed power on behalf of the opp. parties Nos. 1 and 2-Union of India, which is taken on record.

Mr. Satyajit Behera, learned counsel submits that he has instruction to appear for opposite party no.3 and he will file Vakalatnama on behalf of opposite party no.3 within a week.

This writ petition has been filed by the petitioners challenging the order dtd.24.10.2024 passed by Central Administrative Tribunal, Cuttack Bench, Cuttack in O.A. No.260/00092 of 2007 in dismissing the Original Application taking into account that similar question came up for consideration before the Tribunal in O.A. No.213 of 2007 filed by similarly situated employee styled **Natabar Mohanty -Vrs.- Indian Council of Agricultural**, which was dismissed on 2nd December 2019.
