The matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. Mr. Mahanty, learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits, there is some omission in the cause title of the Writ Petition so far as address of Opposite Party No.2 is concerned. He orally prays for making necessary correction. He is permitted to do so in the Court, to be countersigned by the Court Master.

3. Heard learned Counsel for the Petitioner.

4. In view of the limited prayer made in the Writ Petition to direct the Opposite Parties to settle the claim of the Petitioner towards medical expenses within a stipulated time frame, issue notice to the Opposite Parties indicating therein that the matter is likely to be disposed of at the stage of admission.

5. Since Mr. A.P. Ray, learned Counsel, who usually appears for the Corporation, is present and accepts notice on behalf of Opposite Party Nos. 1 and 3, no notice be issued to the said Opposite Parties. Two extra copies of the Writ Petition with annexures be served on him by tomorrow (12.12.2023).

6. Notice be sent to Opposite Party Nos. 2 and 4 through Registered/Speed Post with A.D. along with a copy of this order, fixing a short returnable date. Requisites be filed within three working days hence.

7. As submitted, no notice be issued to Opposite Party No.5 at this stage.

8. Matter be listed in the week commencing from 08.01.2024. Tracking Report be kept on record before the next date of listing.

9. Needless to mention here that, pendency of this Writ Petition will not be a bar for the Authority concerned to process the claim of the petitioner and make necessary payment, if he is legally entitled to such claim and there is no other impediment.
