- **2.** Learned Counsel for the parties are present.
- 3. Learned Counsel for Opposite Party-Corporation files the photocopy of letter dated 20.06.2024 of the Regional Director (Legal) addressed to the learned Counsel for the Corporation along with photocopy of the letter dated 11.06.2024 of the Joint Director, Directorate of Employees State Insurance Scheme, Odisha, Bhubaneswar after handing over copies of the same to the learned Counsel for the Petitioner. Mr Tripathy submits, as per instruction received, instead of producing the original documents, since the Petitioner submitted the photocopies of the document for settlement of claim, it could not be processed by the Opposite Party No.2. The photocopy of the letters



dated 20.06.20204 & 11.06.2024 are taken on record.

- **4.** In view of the submission made by the learned Counsel for the Opposite Party-Corporation, learned Counsel for the Petitioner prays for an adjournment enabling his client to produce the original treatment medical bill along with relevant documents before the Opposite Party No.2 within a week hence.
- **5.** Prayer for adjournment is allowed.
- **6.** Matter be listed in the week commencing from 29th July, 2024.
- 7. It is made clear that if the Petitioner files all the original treatment medical bills along with other relevant documents, the Authority concerned shall do well to process the same immediately and do the needful for disbursal of the money in favour of the Petitioner within two weeks from the date of receipt of the said original treatment medical bills.
