01. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

This is an application under section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in connection with G.R. Case No.31 of 2022 arising out of Baliana P.S. Case No.16 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C.(O), Bhubaneswar for alleged commission of offences under sections 147/341/323/294/506/269/270/188/186/332/353/435/427/149/283 of the Indian Penal Code read with section 96 of the Odisha Urban Police Act and section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act.

Perused the F.I.R.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel

for the petitioner that the occurrence took place was aftermath of an accident in which a person died and there was public agitation and the petitioner has not been named in the first information report and some of the co-accused persons have already been released on anticipatory bail by this Court in ABLAPL No.10128 of 2022 as per order dated 20.10.2023 and ABLAPL No.1324 of 2022 as per order dated 16.02.2022 and after hearing the learned counsel for the State, I am inclined to release the petitioner on anticipatory bail and accordingly, this Court directs that in the event of arrest of the petitioner in connection with the aforesaid case, he shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties each for the like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting officer with further conditions that he shall make himself available for interrogation by the I.O. as and when required and he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing any facts to the Courts or to the Investigating Officer.

The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
