This Court vide its order dated 24.1.2013 had directed the respondents to consider the grievance of the petitioner as contained in C.W.P.No.1414 of 2013 and take a policy decision regarding the allotment of shops which were lying vacant and which could have been used for providing essential facilities to the general public.

The respondents have considered the claim of the petitioner and pursuant to the directions of this Court have taken a policy decision to utilise the shops by giving it out by way of auction to intending users.

Having regard to the aforesaid, I am of the opinion that the order of this Court has been sufficiently complied with. Consequently, the rule against the respondents is discharged.
