The petitioner has approached this Court by filing writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside the E-auction notice dated 11.12.2018 (Annexure P-1).

2. On 08.01.2019, the petitioner was directed to produce a demand draft of ₹10 lacs on account of outstanding amount in term loan and the cash credit limit.

3. Despite of availing two opportunities, the draft has not been produced. In such circumstances, the bonafides of the petitioner are lacking.

4. Accordingly, no ground for invoking the extra ordinary writ jurisdiction of this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is made out.
