Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of Covid-19 Pandemic.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioners directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their life and personal liberty from the hands of respondents No.4 to 10 who also includes respondent No.4 who is stated to be ex-husband of petitioner No.1.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that aforesaid private respondents No.4 to 10 have threatened to cause harm to both the petitioners and in this regard, representation dated 8.1.2022 (Annexure P-5) was given to Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar but till date no action has been taken by the concerned authority in this regard.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Naveen Kumar Sheoran, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana. He submits that the concerned authority will look into the matter and take decision on the representation of the petitioners in accordance with law.

In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar to consider representation dated 8.1.2022 (Annexure P-5) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners.
