Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was working as Patwari on contractual basis and has been wrongly involved in FIR No.274 dated 08.06.2018, in which he was arrested and due to the arrest of the petitioner, he was relieved from his service. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegations leveled against the petitioner in the FIR were incorrect and the petitioner filed various representations with the authorities that as the petitioner has already been enlarged on bail, he be allowed to continue in service.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner is ready to file a fresh representation with the respondents claiming the benefit of continuity in service and the respondents be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any
