- 1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India, read with Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 10.02.2023 passed in CWP-15240-2019.
- 2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of respondent No.1, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
- 3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 10.02.2023 passed in CWP-15240-2019 has since been complied with. An amount of Rs.2,08,02,845/- has been deposited in the account of the petitioner, vide pay order dated 26.06.2024 and demand draft dated 26.07.2024, towards the interest component, has also been issued in faovur of the petitioner. Furthermore, costs of Rs.10,000/- have also been deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Employees Welfare Association, vide receipt dated 25.07.2024, in pursuance of the order dated 15.05.2024.
