**SANJAY VASHISTH, J. (Oral)**

Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to provide protection of lives and liberty of the petitioners, who have married against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned counsel for petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 -Daya Sharma, aged about 19 years and petitioner No.2 – Mohit, aged about 22 years, have got married on 16.03.2023 against the wishes of their family members, arrayed as respondents No.4 to 6. It is first marriage of both the petitioners. It has been further submitted that private respondents are threatening to interfere in the matrimonial life of petitioners. Hence, petitioners are seeking protection in that regard and have approached this Court by way of filing the instant petition. They have also submitted a representation dated Nil (Annexure P-5), sent through registered post dated 17.03.2023 to respondent No.2 – Superintendent of Police, Narnaul, District Mohindergarh, Haryana, wherein, they have expressed their apprehension.
