A fracture of right femur in an accident on 29.11.1999 has resulted in an award of ₹71,000/-. Various heads of claims addressed by the Tribunal are as under:-

3. 20,000/-

Medical bills Rs. 6,000/-

Transportation charges Rs. 5,000/-

Special Diet Rs. 5,000/-

Loss of income due to

10% disability Rs. 10,000/-

Pre & post operation charges Rs. 25,000/-

Rs. 71,000/-

.____

The counsel argues that he had been in bed for six months. A

single fracture of leg of 20 years young man resulting six months hospitalization would require to be supported by medical evidence. All that is seen that he was hospitalized for a period of 15 days for which the Tribunal has provided for all the relevant heads, namely medical bills, special diet and transportation. It has also projected a scope for pre and post operation charges at ₹25,000/- over and above the expenses shown to be incurred through bills at ₹6,000/-. No head of claim is deficient for reappraisal. The appeal is dismissed.
