The present application has been filed to dispose of the writ
petition in view of compromise dated 23.11.2013 effected between the
parties.

With the consent of counsel for the parties, the main case,
which is admitted, is taken on Board. The Labour Court, Faridbad, had
directed reinstatement alongwith full back wages vide award dated
17.12.2009. In the miscellaneous application, it has been averred that a

compromise had been effected between the parties on 23.11.2013 and the workman has been paid a sum of ₹2,37,500/- out of which, a sum of ₹2,25,000/- had been paid vide pay order and ₹12,500/- had been paid in cash. Reference has also made to the statement suffered by the respondent no. 2-workman before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridabad.

In view of the compromise whereby the workman has accepted the amount, the award has been satisfied, therefore, he will not be entitled for reinstatement.

With the above said observations, the writ petition stands disposed of.
