SURYA KANT J. (ORAL)

- (1). Petitioner No.3, namely, Darshan Singh is a Granthi in the Gurdwara of Village Thethar Kalan, District Ferozpur. It is alleged that private respondents No.6 to 12 who proclaim themselves to be the members of "Noor Khalsa Fauz", are hell-bent to remove petitioner No.3 as Granthi of the Gurdwara and also to evict him from the residential premises located inside the Gurdwara. In order to achieve their evil designs, the above-named private respondents are alleged to have misbehaved/outraged the modesty of petitioner No.1 &2, Lakhveer Kaur & Paramjit Kaur who are

the daughter and wife (respectively) of the petitioner No.3.

- (2). The petitioner's have further averred that despite many complaints made by them to the police authorities and District Administration, no action has been taken and that there is an imminent danger to their life and liberty.
- (3). Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the apprehension expressed, especially by petitioner No.1 and 2, however, without commenting upon the merits of the allegations, moreso when the private respondents have not been heard so far, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozpur; SHO PS Ferzopur as well as the Deputy Commissioner, Ferozepur to take immediate notice of the complaints/representations said to have been made by the petitioners, a copy whereof is appended with this writ petition (Annexure P2 to P4); hold an enquiry and take immediate action in accordance with law as promptly as possible but not later than two weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

(4). Ordered accordingly.
