1. Petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant writ petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India seeking direction for expeditious disposal of Arbitration Petition No.93 of 2021 titled as “*Haryana Space Applications Centre Versus M/s Pan India Consultants Pvt. Ltd.*”, preferred under Section 34 of the of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short “the Arbitration Act”) laying challenge to award published on 01.08.2021.
