Mr.Karminder Singh, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of  
the respondents.

In view of the nature of order which I propose to pass, there is  
no need to seek any counter-reply from the respondents at this stage.

The petitioner wants to pursue his academic career in United  
Kingdom. He had earlier got a passport which is alleged to have been lost/  
misplaced by the consultant/agent. The petitioner thereafter wanted to  
apply for passport under the "Tatkaal Scheme" but respondent No.2 is said  
to have refused to entertain the application.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the petitioner's application in accordance with law/Rules and if the application is found incomplete and/or there is any other deficiency, the same shall be removed by the petitioner, upon which respondent No.2 shall consider the petitioner's application for issuance of the passport under the "Tatkaal Scheme" as early as possible.
