**AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral)** 

Petitioner has approached this Court praying for re-fixing her salary while protecting the same and to count the military service and related service benefits as per Rule 4.3 of the Punjab Civil Service Rules, Volume II and for passing an appropriate order in this regard.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that although the petitioner had been making representations for granting of the relief, as has been made by her in the present writ petition but no comprehensive representation has been filed by her. He further prays that liberty may be granted to her now to file a comprehensive representation within a period of four weeks to the Financial Commissioner and Principal Secretary to Government of Haryana, Health Department-respondent No.1, which may be directed to be considered and decided within some specified time.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, prayer made by the petitioner is allowed; liberty is granted to the

petitioner to file a detailed comprehensive representation to the Financial Commissioner and Principal Secretary to Government of Haryana, Health Department-respondent No.1 within a period of four weeks.

Without going into merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Financial Commissioner and Principal Secretary to Government of Haryana, Health Department-respondent No.1 that if such a representation is submitted by the petitioner, the same shall be considered and decided within a period of four months from the date of its submission. If the petitioner is held entitled to the claim as made by her through her representation, consequential benefits be granted to her within a further period of two months. In case the claim of the petitioner is not accepted, the same shall be rejected by passing a speaking order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
