The petitioner has preferred this writ petition seeking modification of the Award dated 18.2.2012 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Tribunal under the Punjab Town Improvement Act, 1922, in respect of assessment of compensation for the petitioner's acquired land.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the parties are ad-idem that vide order dated 30.08.2013 passed in a bunch of writ petitions including CWP No.9250 of 2012 (Ritu versus State of Punjab and others), the matter has been remanded to the Tribunal for afresh adjudication.

The instant writ petition is accordingly allowed in the same terms and while setting-aside the award, this case is also remanded to the Tribunal for disposal alongwith other connected cases.
