Learned counsel states that at this stage they would be satisfied if the direction is given to the respondent No.2 to decide the same by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

In the circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case the petitioners are found entitled to the relief claimed the same be also granted to them within the aforesaid period.
