Perusal of the writ petition indicates that it is in the nature of public interest litigation. Since only one individual has filed the present writ petition and he has not annexed any document on record that only he is involved in the present case, rather a general direction is sought for the consequential seniority of Scheduled Castes category of Haryana Government employees, this cannot be entertained by a Single Bench.

In view of above, instant writ petition is dismissed. However, petitioner no.1 will be at liberty to file independent petition in accordance with law. Petitioner no.2 will also be at liberty to file his independent petition, if he is aggrieved against his own seniority.
