- 1. The challenge in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is to the orders dated 28.10.2015 (Annexures P-7 and P-8). Further prayer has also been made to direct the respondents to allow the petitioner to continue the E-tendering on 07.10.2015 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) as well as to lift the remaining quantity of sugar i.e. 5000 quintats vide which the respondent has made an agreement @ ₹ 2,755/- per quintal.
- 2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition. However, a prayer was made that liberty be granted to the petitioner to file a civil suit for the relief as claimed in the present writ petition.
