1. The challenge in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is to the orders dated 28.10.2015 (Annexures P-7 and P-8). Further prayer has also been made to direct the respondents to allow the petitioner to continue the E-tendering on 07.10.2015 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) as well as to lift the remaining quantity of sugar i.e. 5000 quintals vide which the respondent has made an agreement @ ₹ 2,755/- per quintal.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition. However, a prayer was made that liberty be granted to the petitioner to file a civil suit for the relief as claimed in the present writ petition.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.

4. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to it, in accordance with law.
