

## SANJAY VASHISTH, J. (Oral)

1. Present writ petition has been filed by M/s Avion Fastners, being the Management, by challenging the award dated 12.10.2017 (Annexure P-3), passed by respondent No.1 – Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court-I, Faridabad (in short, 'learned Tribunal'), whereby, Reference No.38/2016, filed under Section 10(1)(C) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (for brevity, 'ID Act'), has been partly answered in favour of respondent No.2 – Sunil Kumar (workman).

Vide impugned award, learned Tribunal held the workman entitled for a sum of Rs.80,000/- as compensation in lieu of reinstatement and back-wages.

2. Counsel appearing for the petitioner – Management, seeks withdrawal of present writ petition on the ground that after filing of present



writ petition before this Court, the parties have amicably resolved the dispute, and therefore, on account of the compromise, the instructions have been received to withdraw the present writ petition.

3. Accordingly, on the basis of the statement recorded by counsel for the petitioner - Management here-above, present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
