The petitioner has preferred this petition filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India seeks quashing of the letter dated 25.07.2016 (Annexure P-12) vide which mother of the petitioner (minor) has been asked to get appointed a legal guardian of petitioner in order to get the family pension on account of death of her father Sukhwinder Singh.

The reply by way of counter affidavit of P.K. Bali, Deputy Secretary, Department of Revenue and Rehabilitation, Punjab on behalf of respondents has been filed in the Court today. The same is taken on record.

From the reply on behalf of the respondents, it comes out that the family pension and other retiral benefits have been released to the petitioner- Miss Eliza Gurleen Kaur through her natural guardian/mother Daisy Harsharan

Kaur vide orders dated 24.10.2013, 25.10.2016 and 26.10.2016 (*Annexure R-6, R-7 and R-8 respectively*).

It being so, the petition is disposed of and the respondents are directed to ensure that all the payment in respect of family pension and service and other retiral benefits on account of death of Sukhwinder Singh, be released in favour of the petitioner-Miss Eliza Gurleen Kaur through her natural guardian/mother Daisy Harsharan Kaur with interest as per Government instructions.

In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of.
