Prayer in this writ petition is for directing respondent No.2 to implement order dated 27.04.2022 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.1 under Section 14 of Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (hereinafter referred to as the SARFAESI Act). There is further prayer for directing respondents to take appropriate steps under the provision of Section 14 of SARFAESI Act and handover physical possession of secured asset to petitioner.
