Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been approaching the respondent authorities for getting his building plan sanctioned, but the matter is not being finalised without disclosing any reason.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner shall make a comprehensive representation within two weeks from today and the respondent authorities may be directed to consider and decide the same, in accordance with law.

In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner files his comprehensive representation within a period of two weeks from today before the Commissioner Municipal Corporation, Patiala-respondent No.4, the same shall be considered and decided by him, dispassionately and expeditiously, but not later than three months, in accordance with law.

With the observations made above, the instant petition stands disposed of.
