The controversy pertains to transfer of Dwelling Unit No.1490/2, Sector 43-B, Chandigarh on the basis of GPA/SGPA. The Chandigarh Housing Board vide impugned communication dated 19.02.2018 has asked the petitioner to “apply for NOC for transfer of said D.U. on the basis of Mutual Consent”.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will again apply for transfer on the basis of 'mutual consent', but the vendor is an old person and is settled abroad. He seeks to withdraw this writ petition at this stage with liberty to obtain consent of the vendor through a legally valid document and submit fresh application to Chandigarh Housing Board. Let such an application be considered and decided as per the Rules/Policy, within a period of two months from the date of its submission.
