Counsel for the petitioner restricts his claim which the petitioner has made in the present writ petition to dispose of his representation dated 06.02.2012 (Annexure P-17) claiming only the salary for the period 14.02.2008 to 12.07.2010 and thereafter, from 13.07.2010 to till date as he is working on the post of Superintendent and the petitioner shall forgo his claim for promotion and the claim for salary prior to 14.02.2008. Counsel contends that petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Secretary, Government of Haryana, Excise and Taxation Department-Respondent No.1 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 06.02.2012 (Annexure P-17) restricting his claim as stated above within some speficied time.

Without going into merits of the case or commenting thereon this writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Secretary, Government of Haryana, Excise and Taxation Department-Respondent No.1 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 06.02.2012 (Annexure P-17) restricting his claim as recorded above within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

In case, the petitioner is held entitled to the claim, the

consequential benefits, if any, be released to him, in accordance with law, within a further period of two months.
